1668	William Adamthwaite	Carpenters Company	of Ravenstonedale	A	William, son of Thomas Adamthwaite of Ravenstonedale yeoman, apprenticed to John Fothergill of Webb St, London for 7 years (April 1668). <i>William was chr in R'dale in 1648 - son of Thomas and Elizth Fothergill.</i>
1675	Edmond Adamthwaite	Joyners Company	of Ravenstonedale	A	Edmond, son of Thomas Adamthwaite late of Ravenstonedale, Westmorland, apprenticed to William Halladay, joyner of London for seven years (march 1675). <i>Edmond was chr in R'dale in 1654, a son of Thomas and Elizth Fothergill. - he remained in London where he died in 1695</i>

1802	John Adamthwaite	apr to James Smith, taylor	Kirkby Stephen (John aged 11 yrs)	CA	John was the son of James and Sarah (Fothergill) - following his father's death in 1796, Sarah married James Smith.
1808	Thomas Adamthwaite	apr to James Smith, taylor	Kirkby Stephen (Thomas aged 11 yrs)	CA	Thomas was another son of James and Sarah (Fothergill) - see above

1829	Edward Adamthwaite	farmer	Woodside, Stainmore	PW	most likely to be <b>Edmund</b> (1877-1851) son of Thomas and Mary (Pearson) who by 1841 was farming at Winton. But it is interesting to find him at Woodside because this is one of the farms where William and Mary (Devis) of the GREY line were living in 1797, and Wm's dau Jane with her husband Chris. Holiday in 1808. Does this indicate a connection between the OLIVE and GREY lines? The other possibility is that it was Edward (1804-1875) soon of Wm and Hannah Whitesmith (BLUE) but by 1841 he was a schoolmaster in London.

We have never found a birth record for him, so do not know if the BLUE line (of which he is the head) links to any other line - though certain coincidental events suggest a possibility that there is a link to the YELLOW line.
